



Prof. Dimitrije Nikolić, MD, PhD, Medical Consultant, Pediatric Specialist, Neurology Subspecialist, Associate Professor in the field of pediatrics at the School of Medicine in Belgrade.

He graduated from the School of Medicine in Belgrade in February 1994.

In 1999, Dr. Nikolić worked as a pediatrician at the Department of Neurology of the University Children's Hospital, and as a consulting expert at the Intensive Care Unit (pediatric and surgical) and at the Neonatal Care Unit. In the same year, Dr. Nikolić defended his Master's Thesis titled: **"The Assessment of Failure to Thrive and psychomotor development in Children with Congenital Heart Defects"** at the School of Medicine in Belgrade.

In 2000, he became a teaching assistant of Pediatrics at the same institution.

In 2003, Dr. Nikolić completed the specialty certification program in the field of clinical neurophysiology of epilepsy.

In 2009, he received the Doctor of Medicine and the Doctor of Philosophy degrees at the School of Medicine in Belgrade, having defended the following Doctoral thesis: *West's Syndrome of Various Etiology: the Correlation Between Neurological, Neurophysical and Neuroradiological Data.*

He became an associate professor of Pediatrics at the same institution in 2011.

In 2016, he earned a Master's degree in Healthcare Management.

Since 2011, Dr. Nikolić has worked as a medical consultant with the Medicines and Medical Devices Agency of Serbia (ALIMS) and as a consulting expert in pediatric neurology at the Institute of Neonatology in Belgrade.

Since 2017, he has worked as an associate professor of Pediatrics at the Medical School, University of Belgrade.

In addition, Dr. Nikolić has participated in a number of clinical studies and scientific projects, and his papers have been published in medical journals.
