



**Dr. Srđan Sretenović**, Medical Consultant, Neurology Specialist, Head of the Center for Headache and Migraine Treatment MediHelp.

He graduated from the School of Medicine in Belgrade, attained his Master's degree in the field of neurovascular ultrasound Doppler diagnostics, and earned his doctoral degree in the field of headaches. Dr. Sretenović is a nation-wide expert in the field of neuroangiology.

He established the first center for migraine research and treatment in the country – the Center for Migraine Treatment at the Clinic for Neurology and Psychiatry at the CHC Zvezdara.

He was part of the team for the treatment and research of cerebral vascular diseases at the Hospital for Cerebrovascular Diseases “Sveti Sava” in Belgrade.

Dr. Sretenović built on his expertise in the Center for Stroke Research at the Clinic for Neurology of the Faculty of Medicine in Toronto.

During his postgraduate studies in Canada, he was a project leader for clinical trials and innovations in the application of neurovascular ultrasound diagnostics.

In addition, he worked at the Center for Headache Treatment in Sunnybrook Hospital in Canada.

Dr. Sretenović is a member of many international associations: the International Headache Society – IHS (a board director), World Headache Alliance – WHA, European and World Neurology Foundations, European Headache Alliance – EHA (a former board director), and the Society of Serbian neurologists.

He is the owner of MediHelp, the first private center for headache and migraine treatment in Serbia.
